Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Who is Chris Strub?

A: Chris Strub is the first (and still only!) person to live-stream and Snapchat in all 50 U.S. states. Chris took a 50-state, 100-day road trip in the summer of 2015 to volunteer with youth-related organizations nationwide, sharing their stories through various social media platforms. Following the trip, Chris worked as a social media consultant with Humana, based out of Louisville, Ky., working primarily with the company's 'Bold Goal' community partners around the Southeastern U.S. In total, Chris has worked in-person with more than 100 non-profit and community organizations, across all 50 U.S. states.

Q: What is I Am Here, LLC?

A: I Am Here, LLC is Chris Strub's new solo-preneur venture, built on the premise that in-person consultations are immensely more valuable than any canned content to be found on the internet. Chris takes an extremely individualized approach to each and every consultation, offering customized solutions designed exclusively for that particular organization.

Q: What will Chris do during his visit to our community?

A: During his visit to your community, Chris will organize up to eight (8) meetings of up to 3 hours apiece with community organizations of your choice. Each meeting includes both a top-to-bottom social media SWOT analysis, as well as on-the-spot content creation (Snapchat story and live video).

Q: How do we know that these meetings with Chris really work?

A: Chris has a broad variety of recommendations available on his website, TeamStrub.com, and LinkedIn profile (Chris Strub). In addition to his trip and recent partnership with Humana, Chris is a well-regarded social media pioneer, influencer, author and speaker set to appear on stage at the Social Shake-Up Show 2017 in Atlanta.

Q: Who chooses the organizations in our community that Chris will work with?

A: Since Chris has a limited time in your community, choosing the right organizations is important. You have the option to select the organizations, or if you prefer, Chris can identify and reach out to organizations on his own.

Q: What organizations around the country has Chris already worked with?

A: A full state-by-state list, with multimedia links, is available on Chris's website, TeamStrub.com.

Q: Can we arrange to spend some time meeting with Chris?

A: Yes, you are welcome and encouraged to meet with Chris, ideally in the first slot of the week on Monday.

Q: Can we come along on the visits around the community with Chris?

A: Yes; although Chris feels comfortable executing the visits on his own, you are more than welcome to come along on the visits to the organizations in your community.

Q: Who owns the content that Chris creates during his visits?

A: The content that Chris creates during his visits will live on his social media channels and be the property of I Am Here, LLC, although Chris is open to creating additional content with the community partners (i.e., dual streaming the interview on their Facebook page, etc.)

Q: What are the costs to bringing Chris to our community?

A: The cost for a one-week visit (arrive Monday morning; depart by Friday afternoon, for a maximum of eight [8] three-hour visits) is an honorarium of \$6,000, plus travel and accommodations costs. Chris will enthusiastically feature the highlights of travel and accommodations on his social media channels.

Q: Can we bring Chris in on Sunday/keep Chris until Saturday, etc., instead?

A: Yes, you can arrange to bring Chris on Sunday evening instead; a negotiable additional fee applies.

Q: Great! We're ready to book Chris. What weeks is Chris available?
